CANDIDATE ACCEPTANCE and TRAINING POLICY

The Para Practical Shooting Section Candidate Acceptance and Training Policy sets the requirements for new members who wish to participate in the sport of Practical Shooting at the SSAA Para Branch shooting range.

This policy identifies the procedures required to be conducted to obtain acceptance to participate.

- The following procedures are to be accomplished before persons will be allowed to participate in the Holster Proficiency training:
 - Letter from SAPOL approving the Training, or current Class H firearms license;
 - Current membership of SSAA Para Branch;
 - Current SSAA National Membership;
 - Completion of SSAA Para Branch Safety course or registered to complete the next course.
- On completion of the above, candidates are to register their interest to participate in the training with the Practical Shooting Trainers (training@parapsc.org.au).
- A Trainer will notify the candidate of the date of training.
- Training will be charged at \$100.00 per Adult candidate. Juniors accompanied by an Adult attending the course will be free.
- The training sessions will comprise theoretical and practical assessments as per the International Practical Shooting Confederation (IPSC) Holster Proficiency training manual, IPSC rules and procedures.
- The candidate will be subject to training based on:
 - Their current competence
 - Their experience, and
 - The successful completion of the section training assessment for holster proficiency.
- If the candidate passes the assessments (both theoretical and practical) the Training Instructor will provide a notification to the Section Captain and Section Secretary, who will notify the Club Secretary, who will then complete and submit the PD314 for H class where applicable.
